All programs will take place at the Betsy-Jeff Penn 4-H Educational Center, 804 Cedar Lane, Reidsville, NC.

Attending 4-H camp offers youth the chance to enhance interpersonal skills, ecological knowledge and personal leadership. The camp is accredited by the American Camping Association and is open to boys and girls for the following three programs:

Camp space is limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis, with enrollment ending on Monday, March 31, 2014. All programs include the following:
