PRESERVING YOUR MEMORIES

Learn how you can connect generations by preserving your artifacts, photographs and life stories on Wednesday, October 15, 2014, at 6:30 p.m. at the [Olivia Raney Local History Library](#).

The first part of the program focuses on teaching participants how to store their artifacts, photographs and documents in the best way to preserve them for future generations. Based on museum conversation practices, this beginner class will show examples of archival-quality storage options available to the general public and provide tips on caring for textiles, photos, documents and artifacts.

The second half of the program will explore the concept of personal history. Tips will be given on how to develop your own life history, memoir, legacy biography or family history into a published volume. Other ways to preserve life stories will also be explored and sample projects will be shown.
