## LIBRARIES ANNOUNCE SUMMER READING PROGRAMS

[Wake County Public Libraries](#) began offering [summer reading programs](#) today Monday, June 1, 2015. The programs, special events and activities help to promote reading and encourage readers to visit the library. Community libraries will have celebrations to launch into summer reading on Saturday, June 6, 2015. Libraries will offer the programs until July 31, 2015.

Children will receive bags and reading logs at their local library. Stickers can be earned when they visit the library by talking to librarians about a favorite book, bringing in a bag to carry home more books or attending a library program.

Participants are entered into prize drawings when they checkout three or more books or attend a library program. Prizes include gift certificates to restaurants, sporting events, salons, stores and more.

For school age children, teens and adults this year's theme is Every Hero Has a Story. The theme for the Read-to-Me program for young children is Spending, Sharing and Saving. This program is funded as part of a \$125,000 grant from the PNC Foundation to provide financial education to preschool children, their parents and adult caregivers.
