REGISTER TO VOTE IN OCTOBER MUNICIPAL ELECTION BY FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 11, 2015

If you are a resident of the City of Raleigh, Town of Cary or City of Durham, now is the time to complete a voter registration application. The registration deadline for the October 6 Municipal Election is Friday, September 11, 2015.

The October 6 Municipal Election will be open to registered voters who reside within the incorporated limits of the City of Raleigh, Town of Cary or City of Durham. If you were previously registered to vote in Wake County, but have since moved elsewhere in the County, your voter registration information must be updated by Friday, September 11, 2015.

Eligible residents can register to vote at the Wake County Board of Elections, any Wake County Public Library, the North Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles and by mail.
