Members of Wake County Board of Elections Sworn in

At an organizational meeting on March 29, the four recently-appointed members of the Wake County Board of Elections were sworn in to their positions.

The State Board of Elections and Ethics Enforcement appointed new members Greg Flynn, Erica Porter and Keith Weatherly, and former member Eddie Woodhouse, to the board earlier this week, in accordance with state law.

The board elected Flynn to serve as its chair, Woodhouse to serve as its vice chair and Weatherly to serve as its secretary.

The Wake County Board of Elections is responsible for conducting all elections in the county by establishing election precincts and voting sites; appointing and training precinct officials; preparing and distributing ballots and voting equipment; certifying cast ballots; and investigating voter irregularities.
