Wake County SNAP Recipients may be Eligible for Replacement Benefits

Deadline to request replacement benefits is Oct. 15

Residents who receive Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program benefits and lost food due to recent power outages can contact Wake County Human Services to request replacement benefits. The deadline to request replacement benefits is Oct. 15.

Eligible recipients should call [Wake County Human Services](tel:919-212-7000) at 919-212-7000 to request a replacement benefits form. They can also visit any of the following Wake County Human Services locations to fill out the benefits form in person:
