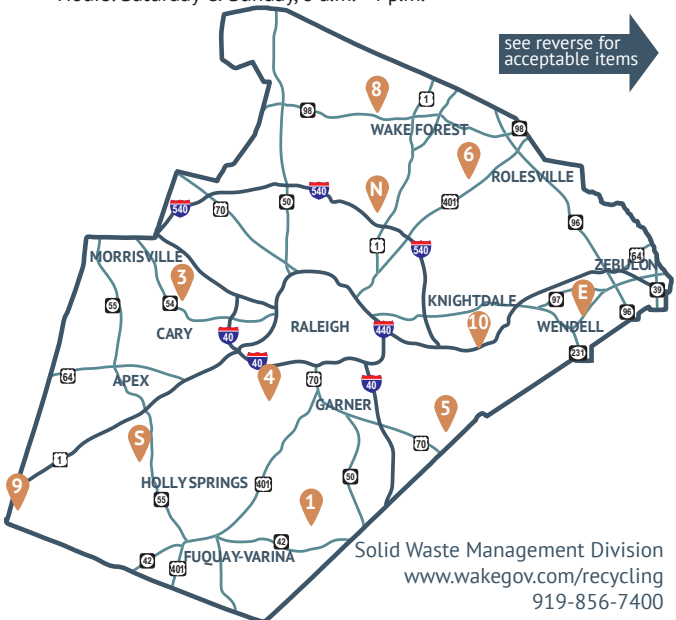

<b>Appliances</b> (a/c, heater units, fridge, washer, dryer)			
<b>Automotive</b> (anti-freeze, motor oil, oil filters)			
<b>Children's Items</b> (strollers, car seats, toys)			
<b>Batteries</b> (rechargeable: electronics, tools, phones. non-rechargeable: alkaline, lithium, 9-volt, button cell, watch. lead acid: vehicle, boat, motorcycle) <i>Tape terminals of lithium and lithium-ion batteries.</i>			
<b>Cardboard</b> (clean, flatten boxes)			
<b>Cell Phones</b>			
<b>Chemicals</b> (acids, bases, fertilizers, herbicides, pesticides, poisons)			
<b>Clothing &amp; Shoes &amp; Books</b>			
<b>Cooking Oil</b>			
<b>Construction Debris</b> (lumber, drywall, carpet, tiles) <i>NO CONTRACTOR WASTE ACCEPTED. No concrete or stones. Sites 1, 2, 4, 7, 10 and 11 only</i>	 1, 2, 4, 7, 10, 11		
<b>Disks &amp; Tapes</b> (cd, bluray, dvd, vhs)			
<b>Electronics</b> (any corded electronic device) <i>Sites 1, 4 and East Wake on weekends only</i>	 1, 4		
<b>Finishes</b> (lacquers, oil-based paints, spray paint, solvents, stains, thinners)			
<b>Fire Extinguishers</b> (dry chemical)			
<b>Flammables</b> (gas, fuel oil, kerosene, propane tanks)			
<b>Fluorescent Light Bulbs</b> (cfl's, bring bulbs in a box)			
<b>Food Waste</b> (food scraps, cooked meats, dairy, fruits vegetables, eggs, baked goods, coffee grounds, tea bags, pizza boxes, paper napkins, paper towels) <i>Remove all packaging from food. Sites 4, 7, 8, 10 Only</i>	 4, 7, 8, 10		
<b>Garbage</b> (household waste, furniture, mattresses, bulky items under 8 feet long/wide)			
<b>Mercury Thermometers</b>			
<b>Mixed Recycling</b> (aluminum cans, cartons, glass bottles and jars, magazines, mixed paper, newspaper, paper boxes, telephone books, plastic bottles, plastics containers, steel cans) <i>DON'T BAG RECYCLING. No shredded paper. No plastic bags. No Styrofoam.</i>			
<b>Oyster Shells</b>			
<b>Paint Latex</b> (10 can limit, consolidate paint) <i>Rusted or dried out paint cans not accepted.</i>			
<b>Propane Tanks</b>			
<b>Rigid Plastic</b> (buckets, crates, baskets, plastic furniture, carts, garbage cans)			
<b>Scrap Metal</b> (bikes, fixtures, frames, ladders, mixed metals, pipes, rims, sinks, grills, lawn mowers) <i>Power equipment must be drained of gas and oil.</i>			
<b>Tires</b> (rims removed, 5+ tires require NC Scrap Tire Form visit <a href="http://www.wakegov.com/recycling">www.wakegov.com/recycling</a> )
