

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WAKE COUNTY UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE
TO ADD STORMWATER REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW DEVELOPMENT
IN THE JORDAN LAKE WATERSHED**

SECTION I

The Wake County Unified Development Ordinance, Articles 9 Stormwater Management is hereby amended as follows:

~~State stormwater management requirements that implement the Neuse River Basin Nutrient-Sensitive Waters Management Strategy apply in both the Neuse and Cape Fear Basins.~~

Section 9-21 State Nutrient Management Strategy Rules

- (A) State stormwater management rules that implement the Neuse River Basin Nutrient Sensitive Waters Management Strategy (15A NCAC 02B .0235) apply in both the Neuse and the Cape Fear River Basins and are hereby incorporated by reference.**
- (B) State stormwater management rules for new development that implement the Falls Reservoir Water Supply Nutrient Strategy (15A NCAC 02B .0277) are hereby incorporated by reference.**
- (C) State stormwater management rules for new development that implement the Jordan Water Supply Nutrient Management Strategy (15A NCAC 02B .0265) are hereby incorporated by reference. These rules shall supersede the Neuse Rules within the Jordan Lake watershed portion of the Cape Fear River Basin.**
- (D) Copies of related codes, standards and guidelines are on file in the office of the Wake County Department of Environmental Services Water Quality Section.**

This ordinance shall become effective July 1, 2012.
