Notice of Issuance of the NCG01 Permit

As the revised NC Construction Stormwater General Permit (NCG010000) becomes effective on April 1st, there are some changes that will affect your erosion and sediment control program. One of those changes eliminates automatic coverage of the permit when plans are approved under your program. To that end, I have created and attached a guidance document to educate and assist you through the changes as you receive requests for plan approvals. (This will eventually be posted to our website.) Also attached is a sample approval letter with language that the state Stormwater Program has asked us to include moving forward.

NCG01 Compliance Plan Sheets have been prepared that can be inserted into an erosion control plan set. These sheets address NPDES requirements not outlined under the SPCA. Yet they may also address what is currently within your ordinances. These generic detail sheets, if included within the E&SC plan set, fulfill the requirements of a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP). You are encouraged to request these. In addition, the combined SPCA/NCG01 self-inspection monitoring form has been updated to reflect the minimum requirements of the new permit. We anticipate a newly formatted form in the near future that will address some of the same requirements listed on the detail sheets. In the meantime, any corrective actions necessary as a result of these requirements can still be noted on the current form. The DEQ [Construction Stormwater](#) web page contains a sample letter, the detail sheets, and the combined self-inspection monitoring form.

We also anticipate developing a general erosion control plan for lot development within common plans of development or sale. If desired for use, this should enable faster plan reviews for the more straightforward and common erosion and sedimentation control layouts.

Finally, there are new documents uploaded to the DEQ-DEMLR SharePoint Local Program reporting site for your use. These templates have been provided to assist new Local Programs with start-up, but have been made available for existing Programs as well. The sample approval letter mentioned and attached above is included in the document list.

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
